Next week is Book Week at Meadow Lane with various activities taking place. This year we are again thinking about the importance of stories and the value of sharing a book with a child, a friend or even reading a story on your own for pleasure. We will be talking about our favourite stories all week and reading together – it would be great if you could support this at home too with maybe an extra bedtime story or book sharing session during the week.

<u>Bacon Butty and a Book</u> – On Friday 9 October from 8.00 am to 8.50 am we will be holding a 'Bacon Butty and a book' event (vegetarian option will be 'Toast and a Book') - all family members and children welcome. During the event there will be different activities to take part in, as well as a free bacon butty or toast and drink for everybody taking part. This will include a treasure hunt with a prize!

<u>Performance</u> – On Thursday 8 October we will be visited by the Hobgoblin Theatre Company who will be performing 'The Greatest Fairy Tale Ever Told'. Following their performance they will be providing drama workshops for the children. <u>Super Hero Dressing Up Day</u> – To finish off our Book Week, on Friday 9 October the children (and staff) are invited to come to school dressed as a superhero character. This can be their favourite real superhero such as Batman or Catwoman. It could even be an imaginary one! All of the children have been doing work on superheroes in school so should have plenty of ideas!

Book Fair - As previously notified, the book fair will be in school all week. The children will be visiting this with their classes and you are invited to come along and help your child choose a book at the times specified below.
