### **Consultation on a Possible Amalgamation of Meadow Lane Infant and College House Junior Schools**

The County Council has been asked by the governing bodies of Meadow Lane Infant and College House Junior Schools to consult locally on a possible amalgamation of the two schools. We are therefore seeking views and comments from interested parties on this proposal, which is at a formative stage and no final decisions have yet been made.

The consultation period will begin on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> April and close on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> June, lasting for eight weeks. It is important that you find out about what is being proposed so that you fully understand and can make an informed contribution to the discussion. The full consultation document, with details of the proposal will be available on the NCC public website from 18<sup>th</sup> April.
