We are planning an educational visit to Manor Farm as part of our topic work on 'Animals', where we will be learning about animals and their care. The visit will take place on Thursday 9 March 2017. We shall be leaving at approximately 9.15 am and returning for 3.20 pm. **If your child is in reception at College House Primary, please drop your child off at 8.55 am at Meadow Lane Infant School hall. You will also need to collect them at 3.20 pm from Meadow Lane Infant School hall.** Please ensure that your child has suitable warm clothing including their school sweatshirt, a waterproof coat with a hood, and wellington boots, as we will be walking across the farm fields. We will also be visiting the owls, play barn and woods.

As part of the universal free school meals initiative we provide a free packed lunch for the children on visits. We would like all the children to have a packed lunch which will include the following: A wholemeal bread cheese, ham or strawberry jam sandwich, a yoghurt, a cake and some fruit. Drinks are not included, so these should be provided by parents/carers. (No fizzy drinks please). **Please indicate on the slip below which sandwich filling you require for your child and return to school by Friday 3 March 2017. Please note, there can be no exceptions to this as the Cook Supervisor has to work to a deadline in terms of orders.**

In order for the visit to take place, we would ask you for a voluntary contribution of £12.00 to cover the cost of the visit and transport. **(Cash or cheques made payable to Meadow Lane Infant School). This also applies to College House parents on this occasion, as the trip has been paid for by Meadow Lane.** The School Fund is subsidising the visit but obviously if we do not receive sufficient payments from parents/carers the visit would be unable to go ahead. We also need adult support on this outing, if you can help could you please tick the slip below and we will confirm this with you before the visit.
