We have been informed by the Local Authority that you have been offered a reception place for your child at Meadow Lane or College House Schools from September 2017. As you may be aware, Meadow Lane and College House are amalgamating in September 2017 to form a new single primary school called 'The Lanes Primary School'. I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to the new school, and explain the class structure for September.

The Meadow Lane site will accommodate the Reception and Year 1 classes, with Year 2 based in the new building at the Cator Lane site. This means that all children offered a Reception place at College House or Meadow Lane will be starting at the Meadow Lane site, and progressing through their time at the school as a single group.

The start/finish times will be site based, and remain the same as they are now. As Year 2 will be located at the Cator Lane site, it will follow its site times. Flexibility in 'door open' times will continue to support parents/carers with children on both sites.

Meadow Lane site - Start time 08:55, Finish time 15:20

Cator Lane site – Start time 08:50, Finish time 15:30

We will be inviting all the children and parents /carers to visits in the Summer Term in order to welcome your child to school. Please find attached a letter from Mrs Revill, Executive Head Teacher regarding these visits and additional information.
