Head Teacher Appointment – Amalgamated School

Dear Parent/Carer,

As you are aware from a recent letter, the Department for Education has formally approved the amalgamation of Meadow Lane and College House schools.

As part of undertaking the work required to bring about the amalgamation from September 2017, the Temporary Governing Body had its first meeting last week. One of its first major tasks was to appoint a Head Teacher for the new school. Whilst the amalgamation process allowed us to ring fence the role for Jo Revill, in order to fulfil the associated requirements for appointment we had to hold a formal interview. We agreed a selection panel, and the interview took place on Thursday 2nd March 2017.

The interview process was supported by Noel Davies from the local authority, whose role is to support HT appointments.

Having completed the interview I am pleased to inform you that the selection panel unanimously agreed to appoint Jo Revill to the post of Head Teacher of the new school, and I am sure you will join me in wishing Jo well in this permanent role as the Head Teacher of our new school.

You should also have recently received a letter requesting your suggestions for name, logo and uniform colours for the new school, and we look forward to hearing your views. Reminder these have to be returned to school by the end of today (7th March 2017).

We will, of course, continue to update you as we progress the work of amalgamation.
