Itinerary for the visit

Medication - prescribed by a doctor only (labelled and handed to Mrs Allcoat)

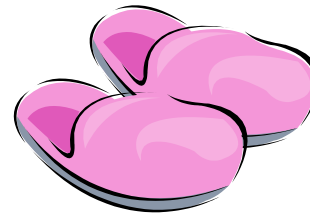
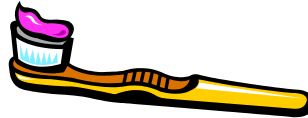
Rain coat
