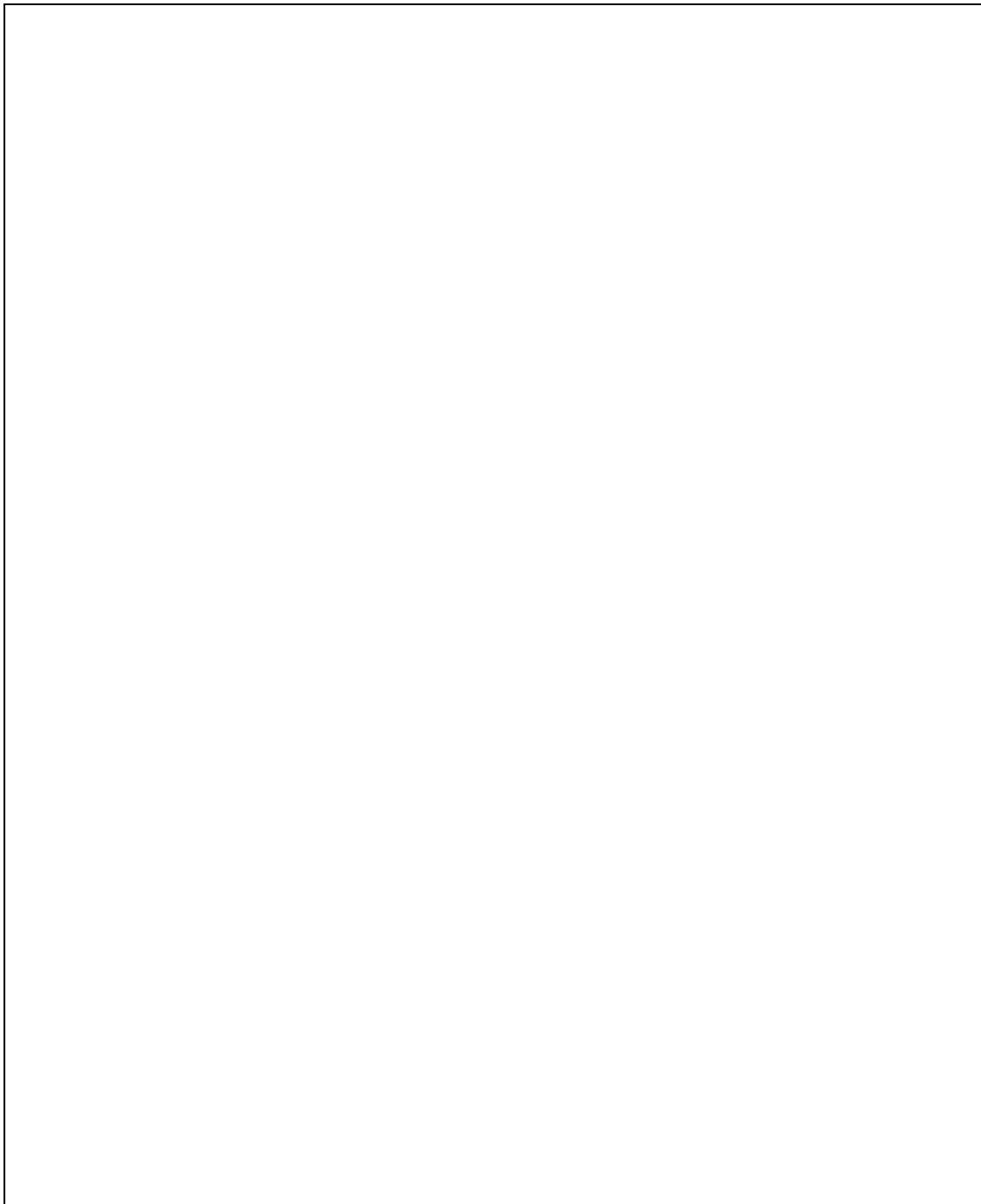

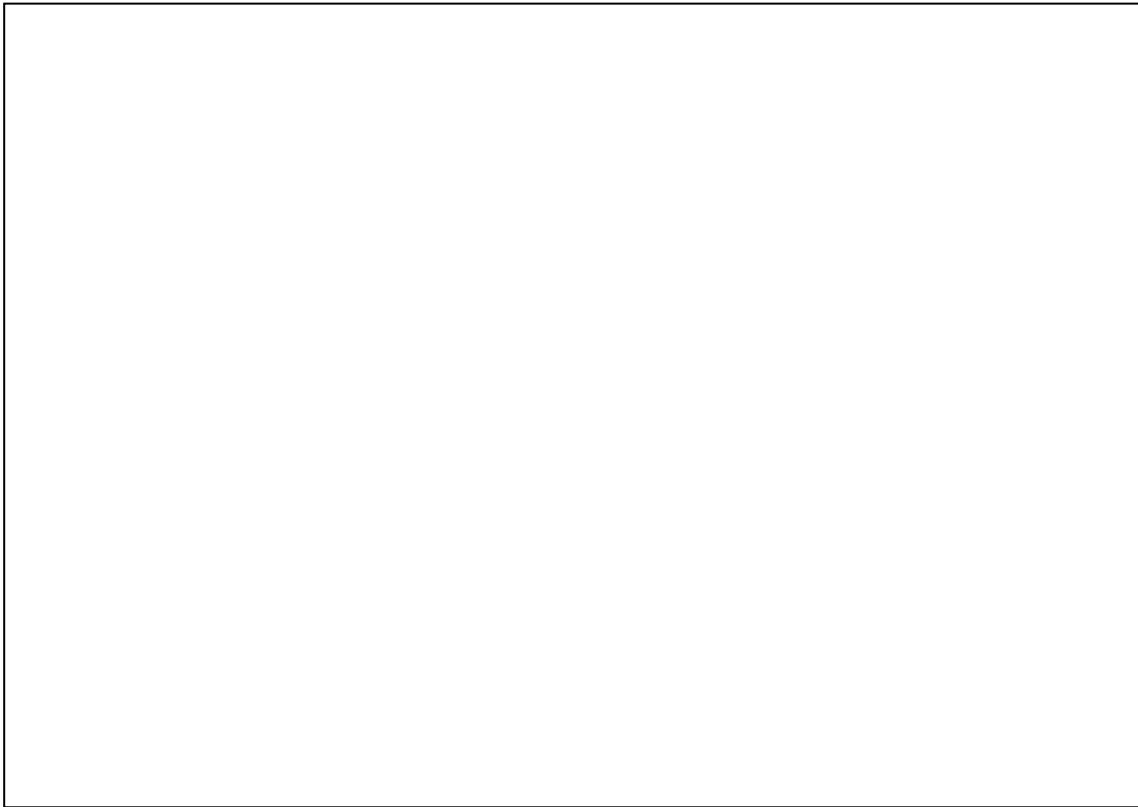

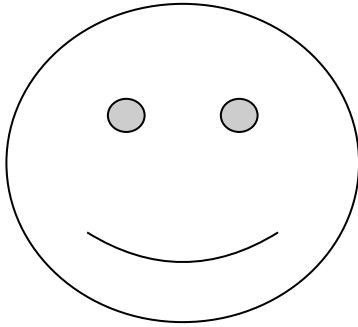


In this box describe the above plant using as many adjectives (describing words) as you can.

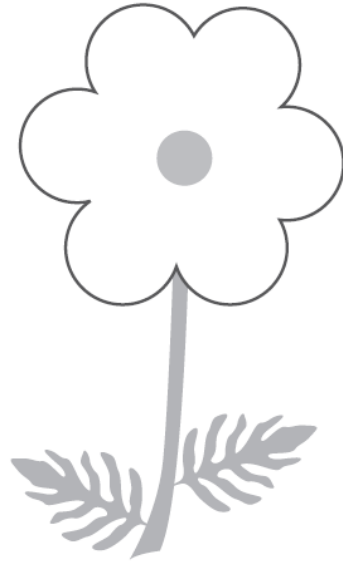

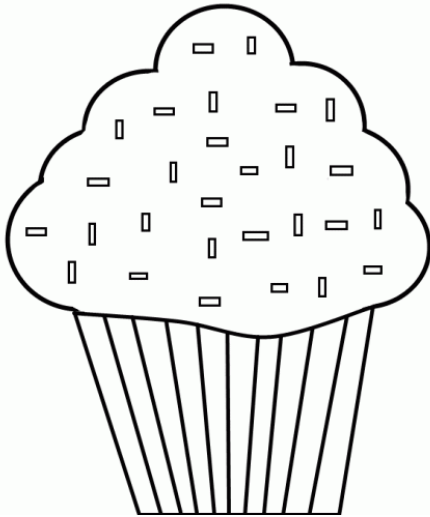
Colour half in pink and half in blue

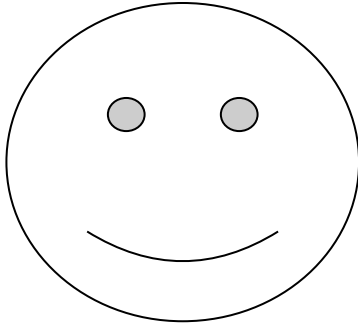

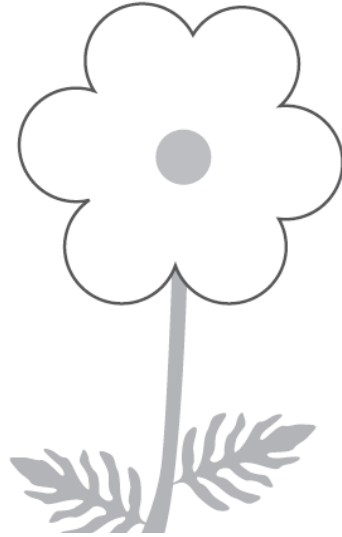

Colour a quarter in pink and the rest in blue.

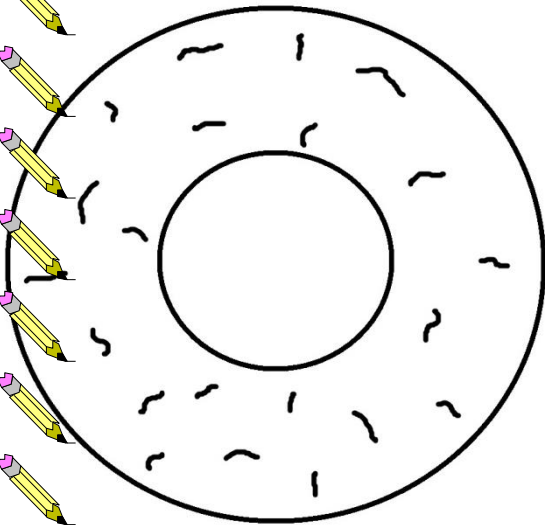


Colour a quarter in red and the rest in yellow.
